NOTICE OF MOTION

---

MEMBER FOR DENISON: I give notice that on the next day of sitting I shall move that this House:

1. Notes that:
  - a. more than \$800million was lost by Australians on legal sports betting in the 2014-15 financial year, an increase of more than 30% from 2013-14;
  - b. while some restrictions on gambling advertising exist, there is an exemption that allows gambling advertising during televised sporting events at children's viewing times;
  - c. research shows that children are especially susceptible to such advertising; and
  - d. recognises the pressing need to act to reduce the level of gambling advertising particularly during children's viewing times.
2. Calls on the Government to amend the *Broadcasting Services Act 1992* to ban gambling advertising during sporting broadcasts.
3. Further notes community concern about the recent increased level of gambling advertising on the SBS, and calls on the Minister for Communications to issue a directive under section 11 of the *Special Broadcasting Service Act 1991* to limit the amount of such advertising.
